General Membership Meeting April 9th, 2024

Order: Florence Charbonneau, President at 7:05 PM.

Prayer by Florence Charbonneau, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Silent reading of minutes from last meeting and we will vote at end of the meeting.

Guest Speaker: Jim Rafferty – History of Marion Oaks

Jim gave an interesting discussion on the history of Marion Oaks. We were established on April 28, 1973, by Deltona. The first section consisted of modular homes and then block homes followed.

Marion Oaks consists of 15,000 acres with designated areas for commercial businesses, hospital, and schools. Also included are specific greenway areas and two golf courses that may not be used for anything other than recreational purposes.

Safety Report – Lt Rosa

Deputies assigned to the Marion Oaks District during month of March arrested 51 people, for 17 felony charges, 31 misdemeanor charges, served 31 warrants, conducted 149 traffic stops, 9 criminal traffic charges, conducted 53 sex offender checks, worked 24 domestic violence cases, wrote 111 long form reports, wrote 103 follow-up reports, dispatched 1,132 calls for service, and worked a total of 1.650.25-man hours for the month.

Lt Rosa discussed the increase of car burglary calls. He stated that the majority of these vehicle burglaries was entry into the vehicle through an unsecured or unlocked door. In some cases, firearms were stolen and even some of the vehicles themselves due to spare keys being in the cars. He cautioned everyone to lock your doors and never leave valuables in your vehicle, especially in plain sight.



Closures on CR 484 as crews improve turn lanes to I-75

The state is advising motorists of a series of overnight lane closures on County Road 484 as crews work to widen the roadway with turn lanes and extensions at its interchange with Interstate 75 and its intersection with 475A.

Crews began widening the stretch of CR 484 from SW 20th Avenue to CR 475A on Sunday. The work is scheduled to run through Friday, April 26.

According to the Florida Department of Transportation, crews will add turn lanes and turn lane extensions at CR 484's interchange with I-75 and its intersection with County Road 475A.

Crews have been working from 8 p.m. to 6 p.m. each night on widening, drainage, and concrete at the sites.

"Please reduce your speed and exercise caution throughout the construction zone." reads a statement from FDOT.

The project also includes the reconstruction of the westbound through lanes and the modification of the existing I-75 bridge in order to accommodate the wider lanes.

The project will also improve bicycle lane and pedestrian sidewalk connectivity through the project limits. Modifications to the existing median will be required for the roadway improvements.

The roadwork on CR 484, along with overnight lane closures and work on I-75 this week, is part of multiple ongoing projects led by FDOT in Ocala.

That includes ongoing construction along U.S. Hwy 441, near downtown Ocala, which is estimated to last through May.

Issues and Concerns:

- 1. Motor homes or trailers that are left parked for years are unsightly to residential aesthetics.
- 2. Homes that are not maintained or have garbage in their yard for an extended period of time can be hazardous.
- 3. Commercial use of property that is zoned for residential use only causes unwanted visitors and traffic flow.
- 4. Homes with livestock or poultry being raised may pose a possible community health risk.
- 5. Tractor trailers parked in a residential neighborhood.
- 6. Builders coming into Marion Oaks who do not comply with our deed restrictions. Builders are supposed to file floor plans and square footage of the house with the Deed Restriction Office.
- 7. New residents are putting up sheds that are oversized.
